Ackermann Nature Preserve

1:00 p.m. – Wildflower Walk

and

7:00 p.m. – Twilight

Exploration of Blue Dell Run

1:00 p.m. We will walk the level Old Dirt Road Trail, then slowly descend the steep but short (400 feet) Wedding Trail to enjoy waterfalls and spring flowers that grace the lower slopes. Wear shoes that can get muddy.

7:00 p.m. We will descend the steep Wedding Trail to explore the streambanks of Blue Dell Run. Amphibian expert Aaron Capouellez will guide us in a search for creek and floodplain inhabitants. **Bring a flashlight** and a sense of adventure, as we will exit the floodplain at night. Wear shoes that can get wet and muddy.
